SQEES Local 298 and CPAS-CUPE delegates met under the same roof to hear Mr. Michel Parenteau, FTQ Coordinator for the public sector negotiation, report on the activities taken place at the Central Table, and also Mr. Richard Belhumeur from SQEES and Mr. Alain Tessier from CUPE, our two spokespersons at the Sectoral Table.

CENTRAL TABLE

Do you agree with the following, namely:

- The loss of our purchasing power, or about 8% over the next five years?
- The requirement to be at least 55 years of age before being able to retire?
- Increase from 4% to 6% of the penalty if you do not meet all eligibility criteria at retirement?

SECTORAL TABLE

Do you agree with the following, namely:

- Reduction of the sick day bank?
- Reduction of the salary insurance indemnity?
- Increase of the regular work day without benefits, without overtime?
- Increase of the regular work week without overtime?
- Increase of employer's rights?
